PEERS Social Skills Group For Young Adults.

PEERS is a 16 - session evidence-based social skills intervention for Young Adults who are interested in learning new ways of making and keeping friends. This internationally acclaimed program, used in over 35 countries, was originally developed at the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) by Dr. Elizabeth Laugeson. During each group session, participants are taught important social skills and are given the opportunity to practice these skills in sessions during socialisation activities, receiving feedback from Social Coaches. Parent/support person (when available) are then taught skills to support their young adults further develop their social skills. Skills taught assist participants to expand their social network and increase their capacity for engagement and enjoyment in social interactions. PEERS has proven effective for young adults with Autism Spectrum Disorder, ADHD, Anxiety, Depression or other social and orders. Group participation is preferred, however program can be d
