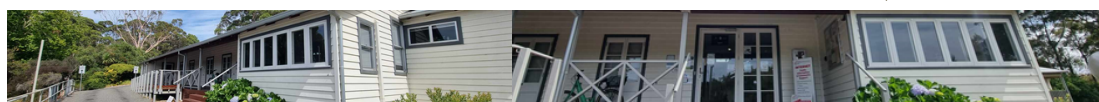
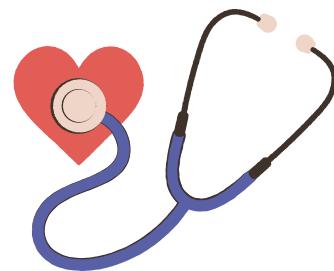

The Pyre will be on display and inviting contributions on the main floor of Denmark CRC from

midday Monday 16 June until 11am Friday 27 June

The structure will then be ceremonially burnt outdoors at 2A Strickland St, in the Denmark ArtsHouse courtyard between 6:30-7:30pm on **Friday 27th June**

All are welcome to attend. Event opens 5:30pm

There will also be a local Life Drawing exhibition event, nibbles (& maybe even live music!) on the same evening. See you there!

Presented as part of upcoming Regional Arts Triennial Great Southern exhibition Radical Futures: Fertile Ground, local artist Saira Ellen K. Spencer invites members of the Denmark community to contribute to interactive project **Burn After Reading** from Monday 16 June at Denmark CRC.

Drawing inspiration from the anxieties, frustrations, fears, hopes and aspirations expressed within our community about bushfire, prescribed burning and cultural burns, for this project, Saira will be presenting a small chapel-like structure (made of dried bracken fern called **Pyre**) that acknowledges the many forms of loss we experience as a community due to fire (whether they be past, recent or potential physical, psychological, emotional, cultural or ecological losses) and to offer a small way for members of the Denmark community to process their grief.

Anyone living in or visiting Denmark is invited to visit the CRC and leave a note or small, burnable object that speaks to their feelings or fears about fire. (note Paper & pencils supplied) inside the structure.

Alternatively, participants are encouraged to express their (perhaps controversial!) opinions on fire.

Saira hopes that by contributing to the Pyre, people will be supported to 'move past' their sadness, despair or frustrations associated with fire, so that they may be better equipped to envision a future where fire is seen and experienced as a generative presence within both our community and our landscapes.

- Share locally grown seed, season to season - locally adapted and heirloom varieties available
- Encourage people to have a go at growing produce, try new varieties and save seed for the future
- Ensure the seed collection is open to all through the library
- Raise awareness around seed issues and food production
- Be involved in your local community
- Access information from the library as you learn and grow

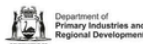

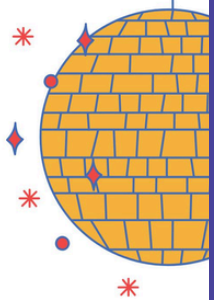

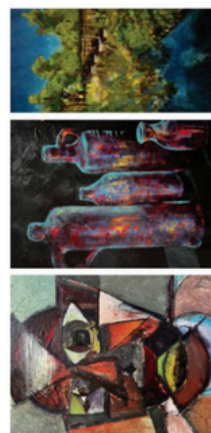
