John Curtin Weekend (JCW) is an annual flagship project run by CVI. First launched in 1999 as a one-day event, JCW has since grown into a large-scale initiative. In 2024, nearly 200 volunteers travelled to over 14 regional towns across five weekends, supporting communities through a wide range of initiatives. JCW honours the legacy of Australia's wartime Prime Minister and Curtin University's namesake, John Curtin, by embodying his values of vision, leadership, and community service.

In 2025, JCW will involve a series of overnight events run over five weekends from 12 September to 12 October that provide mutual benefit for the community and our students alike.
