Come in, take your time, and enjoy this one-of-a-kind display. On now until 16 July – don't miss it!



Jam Room 101 skill set is one part 'gat a band together', one-part instrumental lesson for people that want to meet like minded music makers or get


Beginners through to experienced musicians are all welcome at weekly Jam sessions. The first part of the session will be a tuition style, warming up and setting up before switching to group playing.





