Services Australia Mobile Service Centre in Denmark

On Tuesday 17 February 2026, the Services Australia Mobile Service Centre will be visiting Denmark, and the NDIA team will also be on board.

This is a great opportunity to access face-to-face support locally, without needing to travel long distances.

Mobile Service Centres travel through rural and regional Australia to provide help with Medicare and Centrelink payments and services.

Wi-Fi is available for visitors to the MSC and staff will be able to help you create a myGov account.

myGov is a simple and secure way to access government services online. Our staff provide you with friendly face-to-face service, information and support.

From time to time, representatives from other government agencies also travel with the MSCs.

The team can also help veterans and their families connect to Department of Veterans' Affairs phone line and online services.






