Your drink container's Superpower.

Want to put your empty drink containers to good use and **donate dollars to us at the same time?**

Here's how you can donate your 10c refunds through Denmark's Containers For Change.

1. You can drop your eligible drink containers (loose ones) into our donation bins at the right-hand side of our building and the refunds automatically come to us.

2. You can collect your empties in a box or bag and label it with our **Member Number: C 1027 9818** and drop it at Containers for Change out at the Denmark Tip.

You can Drop and Go if your bag is labelled with our number.

3. You can even sign up online for your own Containers For Change Member Number and nominate to donate your refunds to us. That way you can track your refunds and donations. <https://member.containersforchange.com.au>

4. If numbers aren't your thing... Just tell the helpful staff at Containers For Change that you want to donate your refund to us when you drop off your containers on their **open days (Wednesdays and Saturdays - Noon to 4pm)**

Denmark's Containers For Change is run by Greenskills (a not for profit organisation like us) and last year this recycling scheme put around **\$200,000 back into the Denmark community through refunds and employment.**

Many thousands of those dollars provided a fundraising boost to local charities and community groups via generous folks donating their refunds.

Denmark's First Youth Action Plan Adopted by Council

A landmark strategy to empower the Shire of Denmark's young people and strengthen their connection to community life has been officially adopted by the Shire Council, setting out a clear vision to ensure young people in our community have access to spaces, activities, and opportunities that support them in connecting, growing, and achieving their goals.

The 'Level Up: Youth Action Plan 2025-2029' (YAP) is the first youth-focused strategy adopted by Council and was developed in response to community feedback on the need for greater support and service provision, specifically targeting our younger community members aged 12 to 25.

Following extensive community consultation with over 200 young people, parents, caregivers, local organisations, and Shire staff, the priorities and actions in the YAP have been shaped by these voices to help the Shire create a future in which our youngest members feel included in our vibrant community.

The YAP aims to create safe, welcoming spaces through proposed upgrades to programs and equipment at Berridge Park, the Denmark Library, and the Recreation Centre, as well as building on popular existing initiatives, such as our School Holiday programs and annual Youth Fest celebrations, by offering more free or low-cost activities that better serve the wide-ranging interests of our youth.

The YAP also seeks to improve access to mental health and support services, advocate for better transportation options, and foster inclusion for young people with diverse needs. Additionally, it aims to keep our young people informed about opportunities and involved in decision-making through youth-friendly communication channels and youth advisory programs.

"This youth plan ensures we are doing the things within the power of local government that meet and support the needs of our youth, and grow their connection with our community," Shire President, Aaron Wiggins, said.

Implementation begins immediately, and the Shire will continue working with schools, community groups, and young people to bring this plan to life.
