The Denmark Community Resource Centre's **free** Cuppa's & Clicks program is a friendly weekly session designed to help community members feel more connected, **confident** and comfortable **using technology** in everyday life.

Held **every Thursday from 10am to 11am at 2 Strickland Street**, the sessions are led by our wonderful volunteers Robin, Michelle and Campbell, who provide patient one-on-one support in a relaxed and welcoming environment.

The free sessions can assist with mobile phones, tablets and laptops, setting up emails, accessing myGov, online forms, apps, internet banking basics, social media, photo sharing and general technology questions.

A strong focus of the program is helping people feel safe and confident online, including **recognising scams**, improving online security and learning how to navigate the digital world with confidence.

Need More In-Depth Tech Support? Try Tech Bytes

If your technology questions need a little more time or a deeper dive, the Denmark Community Resource Centre also offers Tech Bytes sessions with one of our experienced IT team members.

These **paid one-on-one** sessions are designed to provide personalised support for more complex technology needs, helping community members build confidence and practical digital skills in a supportive environment.

Tech Bytes can assist with:

- Computer and laptop troubleshooting
- Phone and tablet setup
- Email and password support
- Backups and updates
- Internet and Wi-Fi issues
- Social media and online safety
- Microsoft Word, Excel, Canva and more

Sessions start from \$42 per half hour or \$84 per hour, with Denmark Community Resource Centre **members receiving a further discounted rate.**
