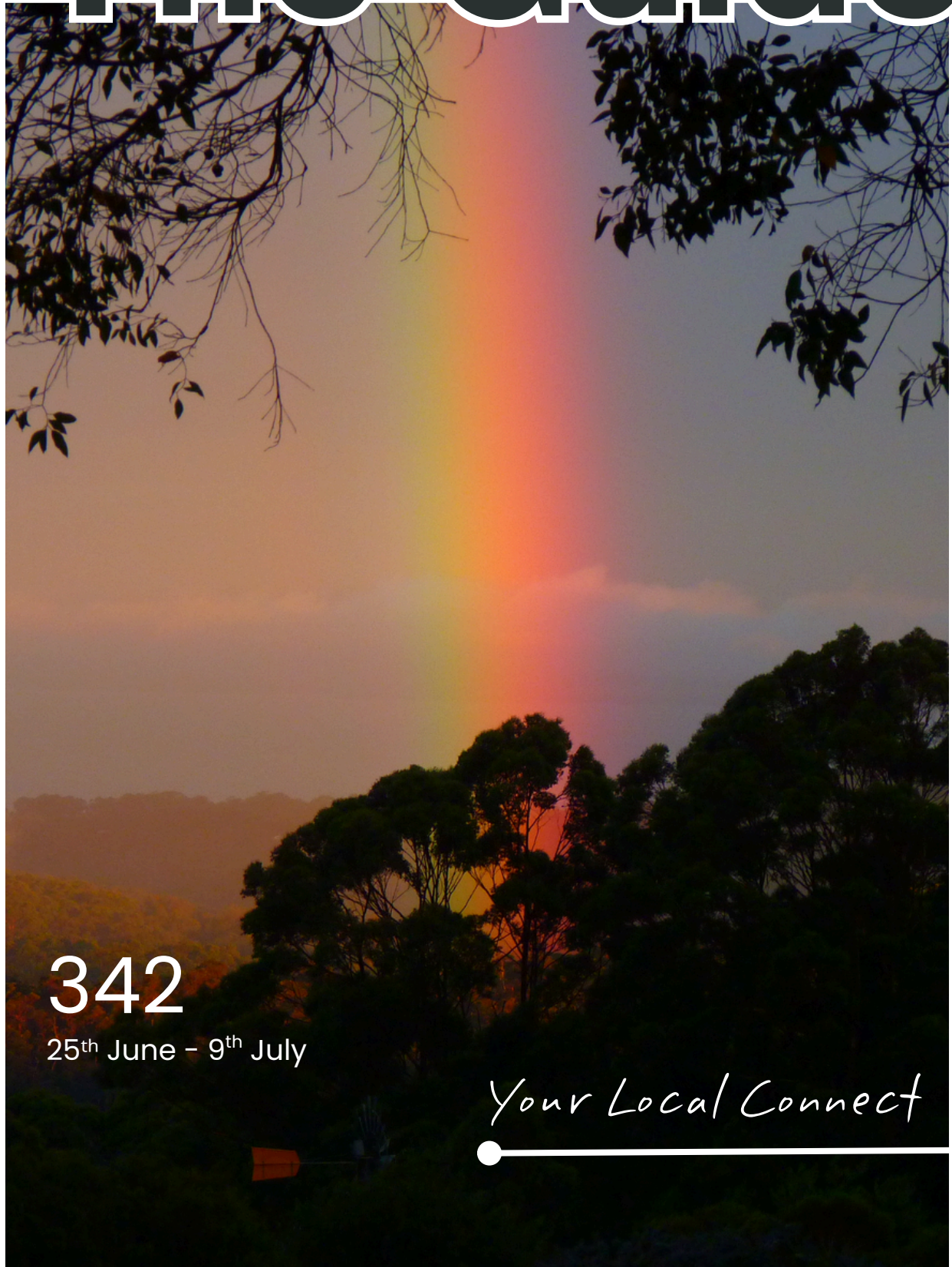

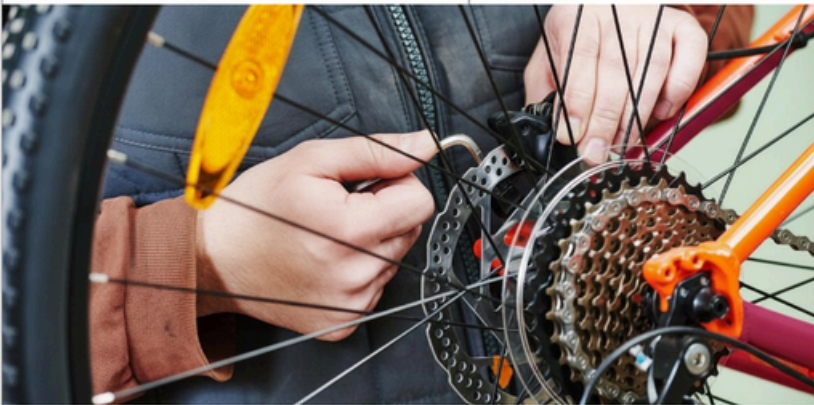

The workshop provided an opportunity for attendees to share ideas, experiences, and practical ways we can better support people in our community who may be experiencing isolation, grief, loneliness, or simply a lack of connection. Through thoughtful discussion and brainstorming, participants explored how everyday interactions and small acts of kindness can make a significant difference in helping people feel seen, supported, and valued.



The Citizen Connector approach recognises that anyone can play a role in strengthening community connections. Whether it is through a conversation, offering support, sharing information, or helping someone access local services, we all have the ability to make a positive impact in the lives of others.

A huge thank you to everyone who attended and contributed their ideas, insights, and experiences. Your willingness to come together and explore ways of creating a more caring and connected Denmark is greatly appreciated.

The Denmark Community Resource Centre will be running another Citizen Connector Workshop in the coming months, so keep your eyes peeled for future dates. We look forward to continuing these important conversations and bringing together people who are passionate about supporting others and strengthening community wellbeing.

# ARE YOU OK? VISIT DENMARK

A simple conversation can  
change a life



The Are You OK? crew rolled into Denmark on the 12th of June, setting up outside Denmark Super IGA as part of their Western Australian Road trip to encourage meaningful conversations and strengthen community connections.

The event attracted a wonderful turnout from locals, with many stopping by to enjoy a chat, learn more about the initiative and connect with others in the community. The visit formed part of a statewide journey taking the team through regional WA, including Kalgoorlie, Esperance, Albany, Margaret River and Busselton, before returning to Perth in early July.

While many people associate Are You OK? with suicide prevention, the organisation's message extends much further. Its focus is on **encouraging people to regularly check in with friends, family members, neighbours and colleagues, helping to build stronger relationships and create a greater sense of belonging.**

The team shared the **importance of recognising changes in those around us.** Whether someone has stopped attending regular activities, seems withdrawn, or is simply not acting like themselves, a simple conversation can make a significant difference.

Founded more than 17 years ago by Gavin Larkin after losing his father to suicide, Are You OK? encourages Australians to connect, check in and have meaningful conversations. Gavin believed that a simple chat over a cup of coffee could change a life.

A key message from the visit was that **conversations about wellbeing shouldn't wait until someone is struggling. Regular check-ins help build stronger, more connected communities where people feel supported and valued.**

The Denmark event was a wonderful reminder of our town's caring community spirit. Thank you to everyone who stopped by for a chat and supported this important initiative. Sometimes a simple "Are you OK?" can make all the difference.
