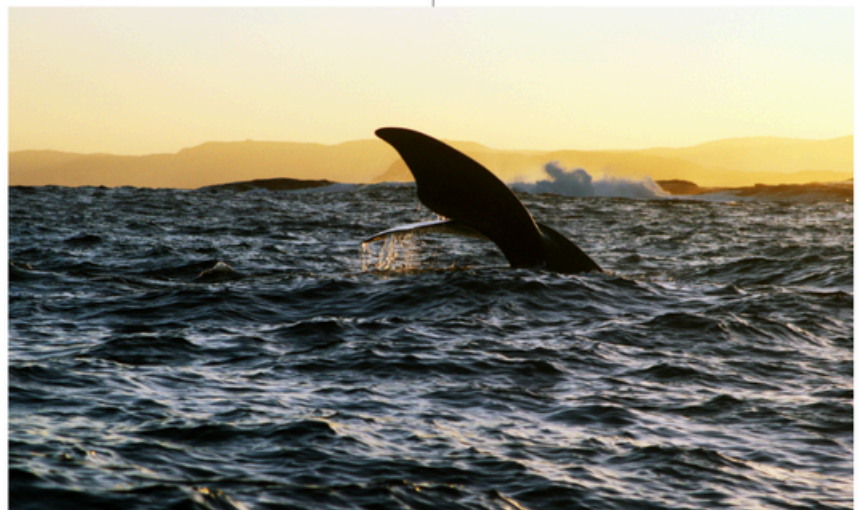

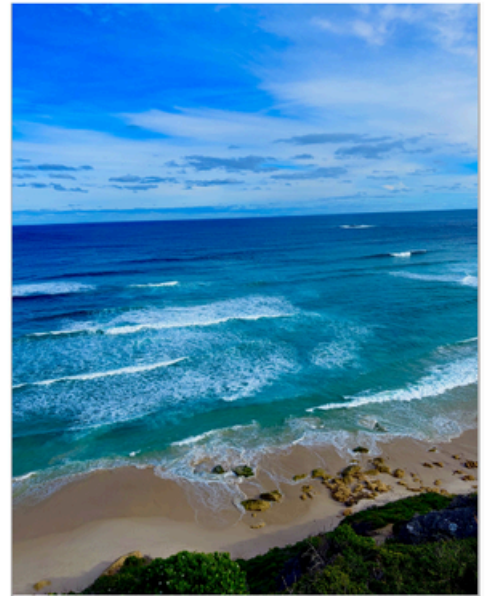

The **Denmark Community Resource Centre** is proud to partner with **Food Bank WA** to provide emergency food relief to those in need.

This valuable service helps ease the pressure on household budgets while ensuring individuals and families can continue to access essential groceries and support in a welcoming environment.



Through Food Bank WA, registered members can access free bread, fruit/vegetable boxes, and yoghurt, as well as a range of heavily discounted meats. Food hampers are also available by pre-order.

During a recent visit, dedicated volunteer Barb shared just how rewarding it is to be part of the Foodbank service. Volunteers like Barb play a vital role in ensuring the service runs smoothly each week, helping make a real difference in the lives of those experiencing financial hardship.
